Nursing Scholarship Program

REQUIREMENTS

The Kona Community Hospital Auxiliary Nursing Scholarship Program is open to all first- and second-year nursing students who have been accepted into an accredited school of nursing. Applicants are scored on their application, a personal essay, college transcripts, and in-person interview. Sixty percent of a student's total score is based on the interview and financial need. First-year students who receive a scholarship may apply for the second year after successful completion of the first year of study.

Second-year students who receive a scholarship are not eligible to receive further funding. The number of students receiving scholarships and the dollar amount of the scholarship vary each year as Auxiliary funds permit, however the scholarships usually range from \$2,000 to \$2,500 each. Usually four to six scholarships are awarded each year.
