The sale is wholly staffed by dedicated volunteers and proceeds are used to benefit programs supported by the Auxiliary.

GIFT SHOP

The Auxiliary maintains a Gift Shop on the first floor of Kona Community Hospital where visitors can obtain gifts and personal care items for patients and others. PATIENT ASSISTANCE

Book Cart: Volunteers distribute magazines and books to patient rooms. The volunteers stock the cart with donated books and magazines that are appropriate for the patients.

Emergency Department: Volunteers provide comfort to patients/families while assisting Emergency Department personnel as instructed. They might be asked to drop off laboratory samples, assist with cleaning rooms, make up gurneys and perform errands, such as picking up cafeteria orders for patients.

Women's Health: Volunteers assist in the OB Unit and screen visitors coming into the facility. They also answer telephones and relay messages to the staff.

Surgical Services: Volunteers help the nurses in the pre-op and post-op areas. They assist the Health Unit Clerk by meeting and greeting patients in the waiting room. They escort post-op patients to the parking lot upon discharge. Volunteers may also assist with assembling chart packets, copying, faxing, filing and answering the phone and taking messages. Volunteers may pick up or deliver items from other departments and cover the front desk when the Clerk goes to lunch.

VOLUNTEER APPLICATION

Membership in the Hospital Auxiliary is open to individuals eighteen (18) years of age and older. Dues are only \$10/year and members are encouraged to participate in volunteer activities and attend biannual general membership meetings. Members who volunteer on the hospital campus are required to participate in a hospital orientation program and are eligible to receive some benefits such as flu shots and lunch in the cafeteria.
